Don't Conform....Transform!

Romans 12:2 says, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect."

How are you doing with the 3:30 journey? Do you remember the verse? John 3:30 says, "He must become greater, I must become less." Those words were spoken by John the Baptist about Jesus. Our series right now is called, "Christ Inspired." What we want to learn during this six week series is how to live a Christ Inspired life. That life can only be attained by making much of Jesus. Making much of Jesus and understanding his will for our life has to come by drawing close to Him in order to hear his voice. We draw close to him by practicing these "Spiritual Disciplines," which are different ways to focus our attention on Jesus.



This week we are focusing on worship in song as our spiritual discipline. I know there are different styles of music and some are more fond of one style than another. And that is the great thing about music. You can pick from any different style you like and still hear God's voice through it. The journey this week was to set aside thirty minutes two different days to listen to worship music while observing the beauty of God's creation around you or just closing your eyes and making the words of the songs your prayer. The world wants to break us away from our relationship with Jesus. The world will be subtle so that we think we can live with one foot in the world and one in the gospel. But Jesus is very clear that we can't serve two masters.




KidStuf is <u>THIS SUNDAY at 11:00am</u> in the Lower Level for all kids Kindergarten through 5th Grade!


