Sunday we continued with our series "Making a Murder" looking at the setting of the murder of Jesus.


God chose the Passover celebration to be the time of the year that Jesus would die. Why? Because He is now the lamb that was sacrificed and to be remembered for all time.


This Sunday we will look at the "Weapons of a Master's destruction." See you Sunday!


Talk Now and Later
