


# News from KCC

You'd think he'd pay it forward and cancel the debt, but that's not what happened. He gets

caught when he didn't forgive others

like the king forgave him.

Bottom Line: Since God forgave forgive should you you, **others.** Forgiveness is full circle. God chose to forgive us when we had a huge debt against Him because of our sin. Because we are forgiven of so much, when others hurt us, we should respond with forgiveness in return. We pray that kids will start to realize how they can forgive people in their life.
