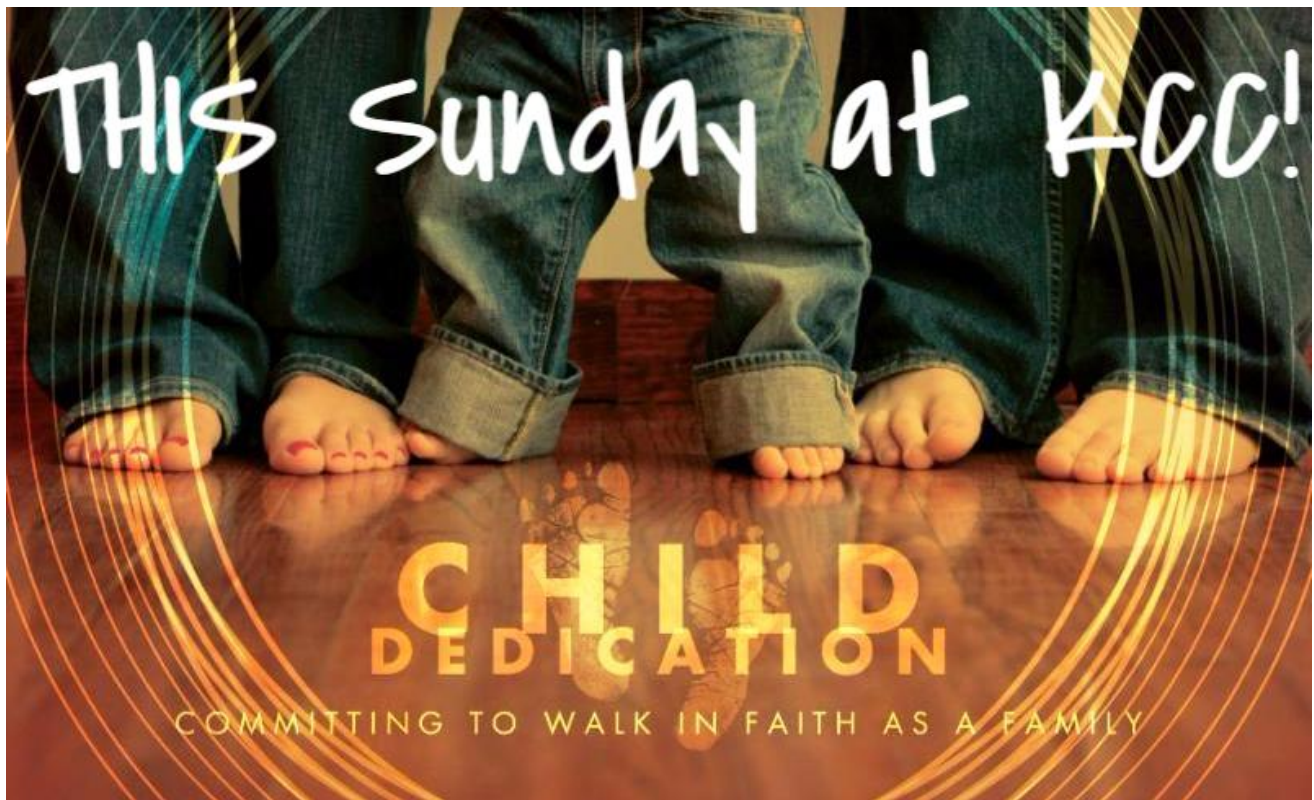




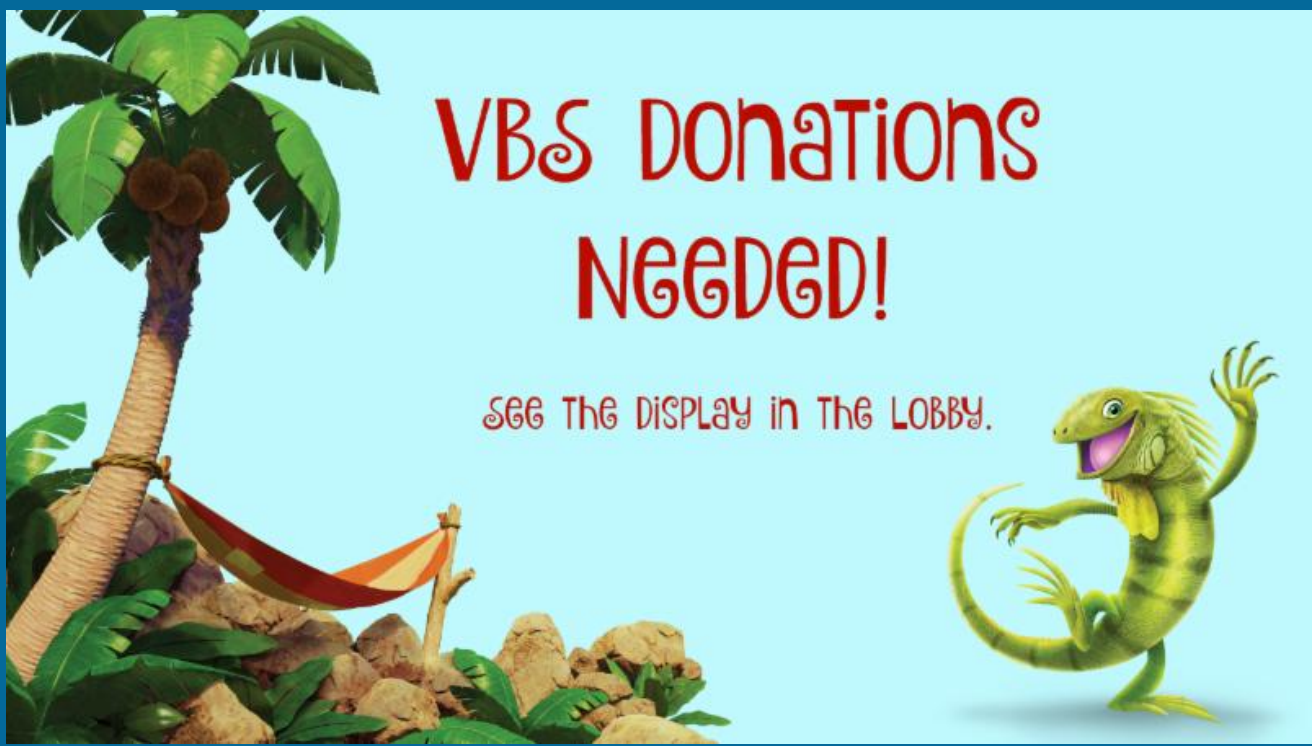

This Sunday at KCC!

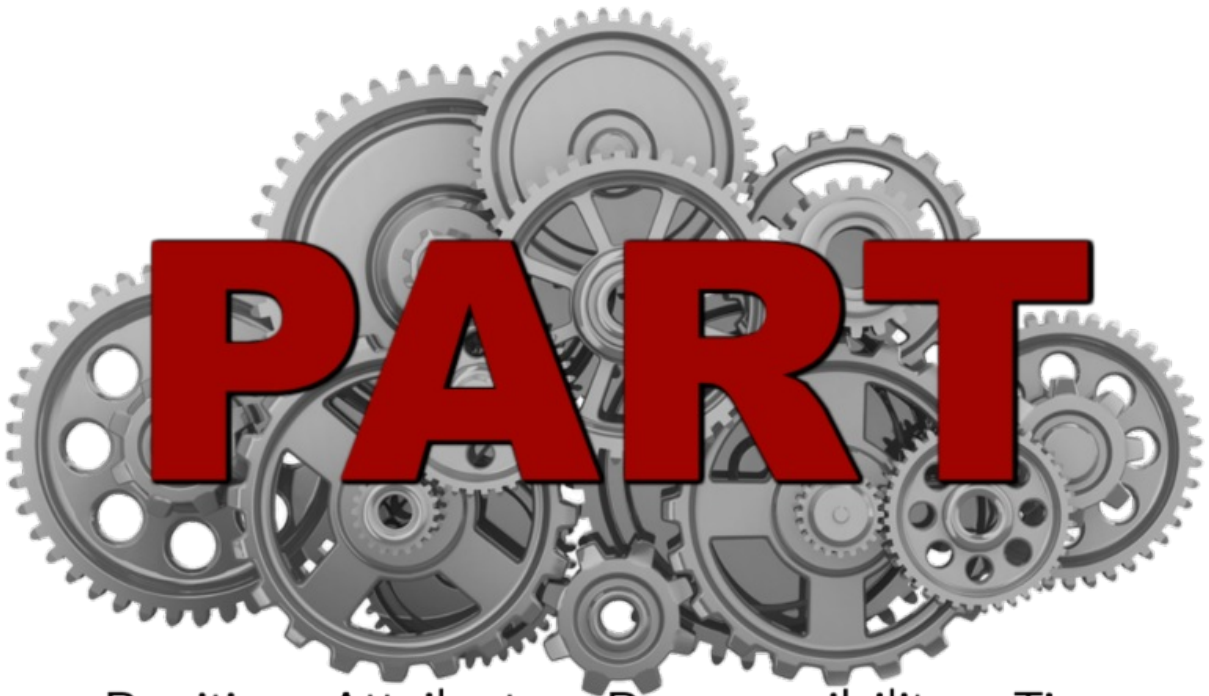

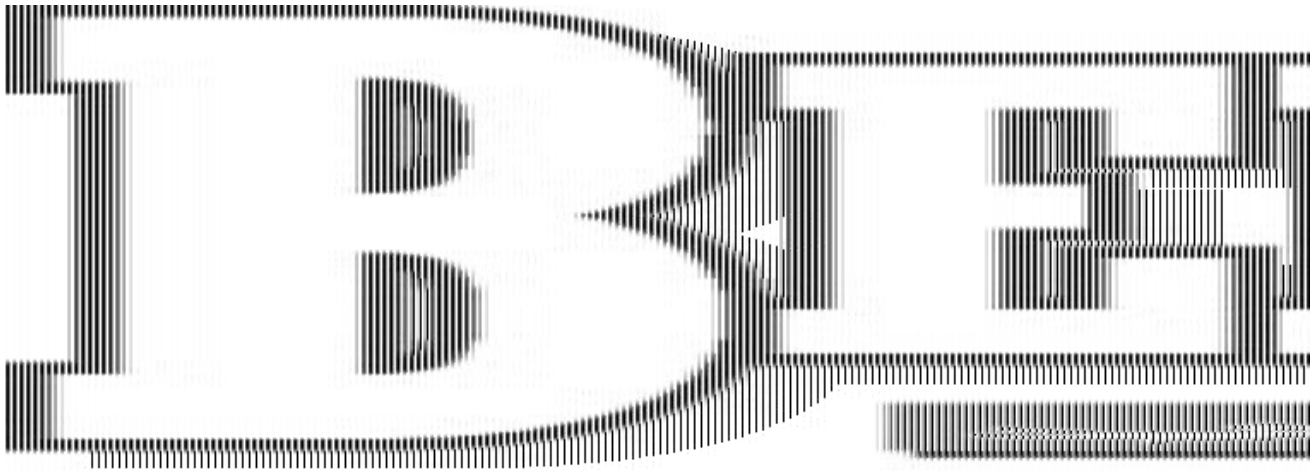

The kids in your group are a mixed age group so you will have some older kids (4th and 5th graders) that will be a huge help with the younger kids. You don't need to plan anything! All of the work is done! You will have a booklet with questions and prompts for group times. You can have a comfortable chair if you can't get down on the floor with the kids, and if requested, you could even have a teen assistant! We have breakfast and devotions every morning before we get started, and you get to be a part of shaping the heart of a young person. I am very passionate about working with children. The interaction we have with them, even in this one week, could be life changing! We are planting seeds! Please join me in the fields. LEARN IT

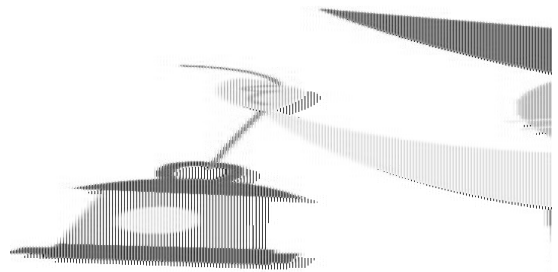
