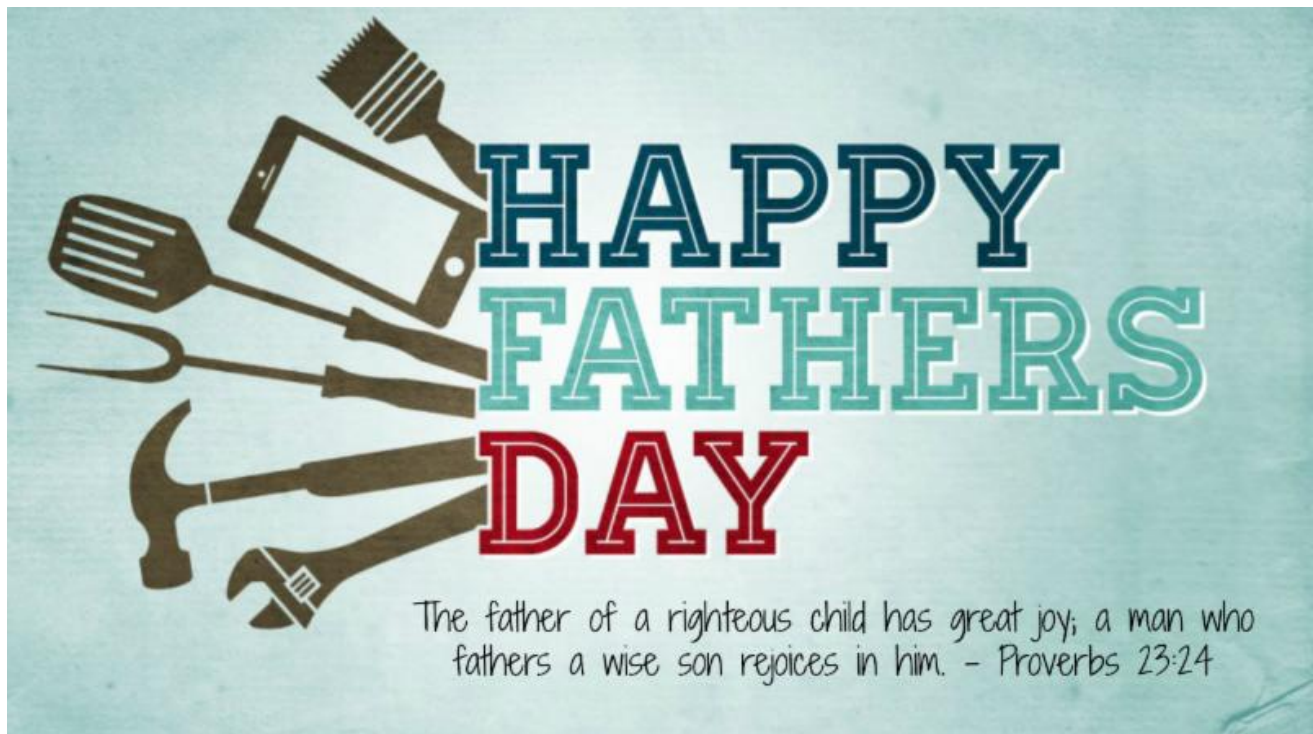

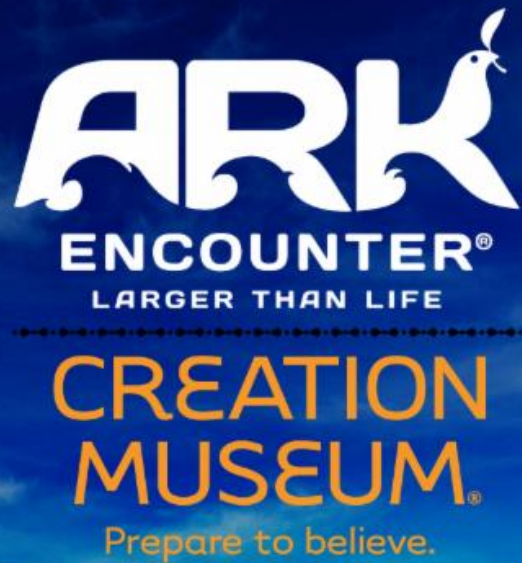

## **Ark Encounter & Creation Museum Trip**

### **ONE TRIP: TWO EPIC STOPS**

Join us this summer for a 3-day trip down to Kentucky in the KCC bus to visit the Creation Museum and the newly opened Ark Encounter!

### **ARK ENCOUNTER**

Ark Encounter features a full-size Noah's Ark, built according to the dimensions given in the Bible. Spanning 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high, this modern engineering marvel amazes visitors young and old. Ark Encounter is situated in beautiful Grant County in Williamstown, Kentucky, halfway between Cincinnati and Lexington and right off I-75.

### **CREATION MUSEUM**

The state-of-the-art Creation Museum allows you to venture through biblical history, stunning exhibits, botanical gardens, planetarium, zoo, zip line adventure course, and much more. This 75,000-square-foot facility has welcomed millions of guests since opening in Petersburg, Kentucky.

Ticket prices include the Ark Encounter AND the Creation Museum. Tickets must be paid at time of registration. Ticket prices are as follows....

- Adults (18-59) - \$70 each
- Seniors (60+) - \$60 each
- Youth (13-17) - \$40 each
- Children (5-12) - \$25 each
- Toddlers (4 & under) - FREE

Hot breakfast buffet is provided at the hotel. All other meals are on your own. KCC has a block of rooms reserved at the Comfort Suites in Hebron, KY. You must call the hotel at 859-980-0555 to pay for your room. A king room or a 2 Queen room are available for \$106.74/night. We are staying 2 nights (Aug. 1st & 2nd) for a total hotel cost of \$213.48.

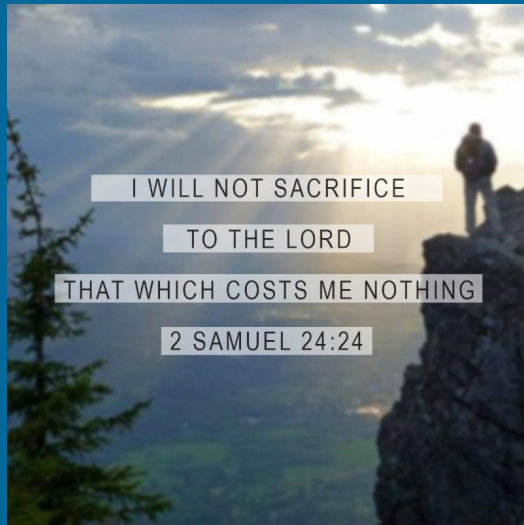
## Why Am I Paying For His Mistake?

In our tough question series a question was submitted about the consequences of King David's sin. The question reads this way, "**Why did the Lord take out his anger on Israel for David's sin in 2 Samuel?**" That is a great question and from one of my favorite stories. In [2 Samuel chapter 24](#) David counts his fighting men. From the story we deduce that David's pride had gotten the best of him and he wanted to



know how strong and powerful he was. Even his general, Joab, who had character issues of his own, said to him, "May the Lord your God add to the people a hundred times as many as they are, while the eyes of my lord the king still see it, but why does my lord the king delight in this thing?"



However, David's command stood and the fighting men were counted. This is a side note, but can you imagine how long that would have taken? It isn't like they had cars and computers with spreadsheets to enter information. This would have taken a long time and man hours to accomplish. In fact, the Bible said it took nine months and twenty days to accomplish.

Anyway, after the counting was done David was convicted about what he had done. He confessed his sin to the Lord and the Lord sent the prophet Gad with a message to David. He told him he had three choices to choose from for his punishment. Three years of famine, or flee for three months from your enemies, or three days of pestilence. David was in great distress over the decision and stated that he would rather fall in the hands of a merciful God than man. And so he chose the three days of pestilence. Apparently, what pestilence means is that an angel of the Lord would start wiping out David's men and 70,000 men were killed during that time. Then God relented and stopped the angel before he got to Jerusalem.

That is where the question comes in. Why did those 70,000 have to pay for David's sin? First, I would say that David paid also in that he would have to live the rest of his life knowing what his sin caused. Secondly, I would say that just because those 70,000 were cut down doesn't mean they went to Hell. We don't know their heart and their faith at that time and I would rely on a just and merciful God and say that those who died with faith are in eternity with the Father and they wouldn't want to come back. Third, I would say that in [Romans 9](#) a similar question was posed by the church in Rome about God choosing who lives and who dies. And Paul said that God said to Moses, "I will choose who I show mercy to and who I will show compassion to." God never declared that "fair" in man's eyes would be the rule of the day.

The conclusion is that the 70,000 paid with their lives because David sinned and God was showing Israel that He is to be feared. He is to be followed. And there is consequences for sin. If only they had learned that lesson two kings after David and not been dispersed and kicked out of Jerusalem. The 70,000 died for a cause. To teach David and to teach Israel. Is it sad? Sure. Families lost their father and husband. Was it ultimately for God's glory? Yes. How? We won't always know. But, sin caused death to come into the world. Not the other way around. This is one of

my favorites because at the end of the chapter David is offered free land to make a sacrifice to God for forgiveness of what he had done. And David replied, "I will not offer anything to the Lord my God that cost me nothing." David learned an expensive lesson. God is not just merciful. He is also just.
