## Where did the giant babies come from?

On Sunday I mentioned the first four verses of Genesis chapter 6 and how they were a little weird and confusing. So let's take a quick look at them and see if we can make sense of them. Here is how they read,

"When man began to multiply on the face of the land and daughters were born to them, 2 the sons of God saw that the daughters of man were attractive. And they took as their wives any they chose. 3 Then the Lord said, "My Spirit shall not abide in man forever, for he is flesh: his days shall be 120 years." 4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of man and they bore children to them. These were the mighty men who were of old, the men of renown." Genesis 6:1-4

There are basically three different explanations given to this passage. The first and oldest is that angels were intimate with the daughters of man and their offspring were giants. However, the problem with this is that in Matthew 22 Jesus said that there will be no marriage in Heaven as people will be like angels. Basically that says angels don't marry and are not sexual beings. I would also add that a flood would not likely kill an angel.

The second explanation is that it speaks of princes and kings. Sons of royalty. The problem I have with that one is that the world was still relatively young and I'm not sure how much royalty would have been recognized at that time. And what would be so special about early royalty that their kids would be giants?

The last explanation that is recognized is that the children of Seth, the godly line, were intermarrying with the children of the godless line of Cain. This seems to be the most logical in our minds because we can make sense of it. However, that still doesn't account for the giants they were giving birth to. Some think that the ten names mentioned specifically in Noah's genealogy were extra special and kids from their line would be giants.

I wish I could give a concrete answer to you that would make sense and answer for all of this. But, the fact is that I can't. What I can offer is that those four verses are a reflection of how bad sin had spiraled out of control and where the world was heading if God had not intervened and started over. I wouldn't rule out any of the explanations, even the first one, because before the flood it is very obvious that things were different. People lived to 900 years old. We can't even fathom the things that were taking place during that time because we can't relate. Regardless, the perfect world God created and wanted for his creation was messed up. And whether they were giant babies or normal sized babies and whether the angels were procreating or the passage is talking about human beings procreating, it isn't what God wanted. The language of the verses would indicate that those involved knew it wasn't what God wanted and did it anyway. That is sin and that is what was out of control. And God was grieved. May we not grieve the heart of God by being a people who choose the opposite of his will.

The state-of-the-art Creation Museum allows you to venture through biblical history, stunning exhibits, botanical gardens, planetarium, zoo, zip line adventure course, and much more. This 75,000-square-foot facility has welcomed millions of guests since opening in Petersburg, Kentucky.

Ticket prices include the Ark Encounter AND the Creation Museum. Tickets must be paid at time of registration. Ticket prices are as follows....

Hot breakfast buffet is provided at the hotel. All other meals are on your own. KCC has a block of rooms reserved at the Comfort Suites in Hebron, KY. You must call the hotel at 859-980-0555 to pay for your room. A king room or a 2 Queen room are available for \$106.74/night. We are staying 2 nights (Aug. 1st & 2nd) for a total hotel cost of \$213.48.


